PMYFCL 2012 Rules of Conduct RevJan2012

All Parents and Guardians must read and sign these Rules of Conduct. Please be sure that you clearly understand and agree to these rules to prevent any misunderstanding. If you or any member of your family has any questions regarding these Rules of Conduct, please contact a Board Member.

- I/we will encourage good sportsmanship. I/we will set an example by demonstrating good sportsmanship and positive support for all players, coaches, official, board members, and all others at all PMYFCL/FLYFCL functions: practices, games, and events.
- I/we will place the physical and emotional well being of all of the players and cheerleaders participating both PMYFCL and all other teams as well, ahead of any personal desire to win.
- I/we will insist that all players and cheerleaders participating play in a safe and healthy environment.
- I/we will provide support for all coaches and staff for the PMYFCL teams and for all other participating teams within the FLYFCL league.
- I/we will demand a drug, alcohol, and tobacco free environment for all of the youth participants and agree to refrain from their use at all PMYFCL/FLYFCL events.
- I/we understand and agree that these games and events are for the benefit of all of the youth participants and not adults.
- I/we will require that I/we and our children treat all other players, cheerleaders, coaches, officials, and adults for the PMYFCL teams and all other FLYFCL participating teams as well, with respect.
- I/we will refrain from the use of profane and/or abusive language and conduct at all PMYFCL/FLYFCL events.
- I/we understand and agree that any violations of any aspect of these Rules of Conduct can result in my/our dismissal and suspension from PMYFCL/FLYFCL events. Continued violations of the Rules of conduct may result in permanent dismissal from attending all PMYFCL/FLYFCL events.
- It is the responsibility of the participant and his or her parents and or guardians to return all issued equipment and uniforms at the completion of the season on the designated days in clean and satisfactory condition (excluding normal usage) in order for the participant to receive their free banquet ticket and or end of year trophy. The replacement costs for any missing and/or unsatisfactory condition equipment and uniforms will be the responsibility of the participant's parent/guardian. When costs are paid the participant will receive their banquet ticket and or trophy.
- By signing below I/we understand, agree, and will abide by these Rules of Conduct while attending all PMYFCL/FLYFCL events, in order to participate in the following year. By signing we also agree on the equipment and uniform conditions.
