

2012 Parents Agreement

We support the National Sports Coaches Association's campaign to prevent Drug and Alcohol Abuse through education and positive sports experience.

I understand that as parent of a participant, I must monitor my child's activities in regards to the fund-raisers. I agree that my child will participate in all the fund-raisers including the raffle ticket fundraiser and sell at least (40) \$2.00 tickets (\$80.00) OR pay the buyout price for each child enrolled. I agree and understand that if I/we have enrolled in the Family Plan each participant must sell (20) \$2.00 tickets each, equaling \$40.00.

I will accept responsibility for insuring that my child's obligations are carried out and that all monies due to the Pal-Mac Youth Football and Cheerleading League Organization are paid when they are due. I also understand that if I fail to turn in money on the due date, the player/cheerleader will be ineligible to play until the monies are received.

I understand that there will be a \$25.00 bounce check fee owed to Pal-Mac Youth Football and Cheerleading League on top of any bank charges and that my child will not play in a regulation game until this fee is paid in full.

I understand that as a parent of a participant that I must work at least two times per child and it is my responsibility to sign up for these positions. I understand it is my responsibility to contact the Workers Board Coordinator 24 hours prior to the game if I am unable to work and make arrangements to reschedule my time. If I fail to contact the workers board 24 hours prior, I understand that my child will not play the following week. The parent must sign up for the next available shift/duty to fulfill the obligation set forth by the league. If the parent does not show for work on the last game of the season the child will not play the first game the following year and the parent must work the first available opening (off season registration, parents meeting or during a preseason game) prior to their child playing the first regulation game.

I understand that the equipment issued to my child is not our property and must be turned in at the end of the season in the same condition as when issued. I will be signing for the equipment and I am financially responsible to pay Pal-Mac Youth Football and Cheerleading League for any equipment damaged or not returned by the scheduled equipment turn-in date. A 25.00 late fee will be applied to the player's dues the following year, if there is a failure to meet the equipment hand-in date unless an agreement has been made with the Equipment Director in advance.

I understand and sign that it is my responsibility to read, and have read, the 2012 Parents Handbook.

I understand that PMYFCL has a **NO REFUND POLICY** regarding registration fees. PMYFCL will not refund any monies received for registration unless participation is restricted due to a documented medical condition prior to August 1st.
